ONLINE FID: Drawings for the future

FID'S MISSION IS TO PROMOTE THE XXIST CENTURY EUROPEAN DRAWING, THROUGH SUPPORTING NEW ARTISTS AND ASSISTING YOUNG CONTEMPORARY ART COLLECTORS.

FID imagines new projects, assists in designing and formulating them as major cultural events to the benefice of young sketching artists.

OUR OBJECTIVE

is to show the drawing in the process of being executed, the tomorrow drawing, through increased professionalism of students and young graduates selected from the whole world by a jury of specialists in contemporary drawing.

Exhibitors will offer their sketches for sale by posting them on Online FID. This professional visibility will constitute a definitive advantage in the launching of their artistic carrier. A drawing of each exhibitor is to illustrate an issue of the Online FID Newsletter.

In 2011, the FID Jury Prize was awarded to Camille Nicolle : she benefited from a dedicated exhibition in "Galerie Catherine Putman" in Paris. In 2010, the FID Jury Prize was awarded to Kristina Heckova. She showed three dedicated exhibitions in Beijing and Paris ("Hadrien de Montferrand Gallery" and "La Galerie particulière Gallery").

The three winners of the Online FID 2012 Prize will be offered dedicated exhibitions in galleries specialized in contemporary drawing : Catherine Putman Gallery (Paris, France), LWS Gallery (Paris, France) and Twilight Zone Gallery (Tournai, Belgium).

THANKS TO ITS UNIQUE APPROACH to selecting new talents who will influence tomorrow's trends in the art market, this year more than ever is FID in a position to access international art market by proposing with its 4th edition a virtual online sale platform. From june 15th onto 21st 2012, collectors will have opportunity to buy pieces of art reflecting the today drive of contemporary creation.

Since 2009, year of its first fair, FID has become the unique place where young collectors and amateurs are able to secure the acquisition of original pieces, selected by a jury of international experts, at very reasonable prices i.e. from 200€ to about 600€. Furthermore, FID is a key event for the professionals of emerging talent : multiple aesthetic trends are showed, without any formal or conceptual exclusion. The FID prize laureates of 2010, 2011 and 2012 will exhibit their works at the Crous gallery (Paris), as a preview of a major international art event, i.e. the exhibition devoted to all FID laureates, 2010 through 2013, at the Cluj Art Museum, co-organized with the Art & Design University of Cluj - Napoca (Romania).





EXHIBITORS SELL ON LINE THEIR DRAWINGS TO THE ART PROFESSIONALS AND TO THE PUBLIC.

Payments are to be made by Paypal or credit cards. Delivery in France and abroad will be executed as soon as the fair is closed.

The prices of the drawings range from $200 \in$ up to $600 \in$. The non-profit cultural organization supports all the expenses associated with the fair. Exhibitors contribute to the organization through atributing 30% of the total sale proceeds to the organization.
